

Youth Leader

The youth leader's primary purpose is to provide general oversight of the youth ministries of New Hope Assembly of God. The youth leader will provide leadership which results in the evangelizing, discipling, and commissioning of youth in grades 6 – 12.

Responsibilities:

- Develop a Spirit-lead vision statement for the youth ministries. This vision statement will serve to provide direction and clarity to all events and functions of the various youth ministries.
- Develop specific goals and strategies which will achieve the above vision for the ministries
- Recruit, train, and coach appropriate staff members
- Provide administrative oversight of youth ministries including, but not limited to, attendance and demographics tracking, permission slips for events, communications with parents/guardians of youth, and the financial management of budgeting, spending, and fundraising.
- Proficiently teach and preach the word of God and the relevant application of it
- Regularly communicate with the senior pastor regarding the youth ministries and personal spiritual health
- Communicate with the overseeing elder of the youth ministries on a monthly basis any updates regarding youth ministries

Prerequisites:

- Those requirements found in the service handbook for leading ministry
- A clear call to youth ministry
- The ability to relate to and build relationships with youth
- Previous experience in youth ministry preferred, but not required
- Ministry credentials preferred, but not required
